

As outlined in yesterday's correspondence from the CEO, CourtPath Version 2 (Electronic Court File (ECF) Replacement) will be available to everyone from **Monday, 18th March.**

CourtPath Version 2 (ECF Replacement) has been built to replace the existing ECF. Initially, CourtPath will operate alongside the ECF, however that system will be decommissioned later this year, subject to successful implementation. Until then, information (including documents and data) in each system is automatically reflected in CourtPath, and vice-versa.

CourtPath offers many benefits and efficiencies, including simpler access to files, documents and sittings information. CourtPath will continue to improve over time, and will also ultimately replace Casetrack, to provide a single Case Management System for the Courts.

Further information about how CourtPath can help you to manage your work is available in this <u>one-page overview</u>, and a short (3-minute) <u>introductory video</u> is also available. Important information about the launch:

ECF Replacement - CourtPath (General Federal Law)

In the next few weeks, CourtPath Version 2 (ECF Replacement) will be launched for FCA and FCFCOA (Division2) general federal law and multijurisdictional users. Please see below an update on the project's progress:

- **Pilot**: A 'live' version of CourtPath Version 2 has been evaluated over the past three months, with around 80 people, including Judges, Registrars, Chambers staff, Legal Case Managers (LCMs) and Registry staff. The pilot program has received positive feedback, with users reporting that the new system is easy to use, intuitive, and facilitates easy file retrieval. We thank the pilot group for their time, engagement and suggestions.
- Replacing the ECF: Initially, CourtPath will operate alongside the ECF, however the ECF will be
 decommissioned later this year. Information (including documents and data) in each system is
 automatically reflected in CourtPath, and vice-versa.
- **Continued access to Casetrack**: CourtPath is not yet a replacement for Casetrack. Both versions of Casetrack will remain in their current form and will be replaced in future project phases.
- **Preparing to launch**: The team is finalising launch preparations. Below are some important details about when and how this will happen:
 - o **Timeframes**: Dates will be confirmed soon, however access to CourtPath will be available to everyone in the coming weeks. The ECF will remain operational until further notice.
