This application is made under section 447A of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth) (**Act**) and section 90-15 of the Insolvency Practice Schedule (Corporations), being Schedule 2 to the Act (**IPSC**).

In this proceeding, the Court has made orders allowing eight industrial associations (**Unions**), who have members employed by various of the second to forty-second defendants (**Virgin Companies**), to represent those members at forthcoming meetings of creditors of the Virgin Companies (**Second Meetings**).

In this application, the Unions seek an order that the names of members of the respective Unions who are deemed by the orders to have appointed an attorney (**Relevant Members**) not be disclosed in the minutes of the Second Meetings.

On the facts stated in the supporting affidavit(s), the plaintiffs apply for the following relief:

- 1. An order abridging the time for service of this interlocutory process.
- An order under section 447A of the Act and 90-15 of the IPSC that Part 5.3A of the Act is to operate such that the record required under r 75-145(4) of the Insolvency Practice Rules (Corporations) (IPR) be prepared in a manner that does not identify by name the Relevant Members present at the Second Meetings.
- 3. Alternatively to paragraph 2, orders under section 447A of the Act and 90-15 of the IPSC that Part 5.3A of the Act is to operate such that:
 - (a) the first defendants prepare the record of persons present at the Second Meetings under r 75-145(4) of the IPR so that names of the Relevant Members present at the Second Meetings is recorded in a schedule (Schedule);

- (b) the Schedule is not to be available for inspection by creditors or contributor under r 75-145(5) of the IPR; and
- (c) the Schedule is not to be lodged with ASIC under r 75-145(1)(c) of the IPR.
- 4. An order that the Plaintiffs' reasonable costs of and incidental to this application and the Defendants' costs of and incidental to this application, be costs in the administrations of the Virgin Companies..
- 5. An order that any person who can demonstrate a sufficient interest has liberty to apply to vary or discharge any orders made pursuant to paragraphs 1 and 2 above, on 3 business days' written notice being given to the Plaintiffs and to the Associate to Justice Middleton.
- 6. Such further or other order as the Court sees fit.
