THE COURT ORDERS THAT:

1. Pursuant to r 30.11 of the *Federal Court Rules 2011* (Cth), this proceeding be heard together with proceeding numbers VID216/2024 and VID222/2024, with evidence in one proceeding being evidence in each other proceeding.

- 2. The time for compliance with order 2 of the orders made on 2 February 2024, being the time by which the parties are to file and serve any affidavits or expert reports relevant to the issues on which they bear the onus of proof, be extended to 4.00 pm on 27 May 2024.
- 3. The time for compliance with order 3 of the orders made on 2 February 2024, being the time by which each party give standard discovery, be extended to 4.00 pm on 3 June 2024.
- 4. The time for compliance with order 4 of the orders made on 2 February 2024, being the time by which the parties are to file and serve any affidavits or expert reports in reply, be extended to 4.00 pm on 15 July 2024.
- 5. The case management hearing listed at 9.30 am on 26 April 2024 be refixed to 9.30 am on 26 July 2024.



- 6. The period specified in order 6 of the orders made on 2 February 2024, being the period for which the trial of the proceeding is listed, be extended to 15 days.
- 7. If the solicitors for either party form the view that the party for whom they act will likely not comply with any order of the Court in this proceeding, then as soon as practicable they are to
 - (a) notify the solicitors for the other party; and
 - (b) notify Chambers, identifying whether the proceeding should be listed for a further case management hearing.

OTHER MATTERS:

Time will be of the essence in relation to the parties' compliance with the Court's orders in this proceeding.
