Details of claim

On the grounds stated in the statement of claim (**SOC**), the Applicant claims the following relief:

1. Declarations pursuant to section 21 of the *Federal Court of Australia Act 1976* (Cth) (**FCA Act**) and/or section 562 of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth) (**FW Act**) that Seven Network:
 - a. committed a serious contravention of section 44 of the FW Act as pleaded in paragraph 30 of the SOC;
 - b. contravened section 44 of the FW Act as pleaded in paragraph 49 of the SOC and
 - c. contravened section 340 of the FW Act as set out in paragraphs 42, 59, and 67 of the SOC.
2. Orders pursuant to section 546 of the FW Act for the imposition of pecuniary penalties upon the Respondent for their contraventions of s44 and s 340 of the FW Act.
3. Orders pursuant to s.545 of the FW Act that the Respondent pay compensation to the Applicant for their economic and non-economic loss suffered as a consequence of the contraventions of the FW Act.
4. Orders pursuant to s.546 of the FW Act that any pecuniary penalties imposed by the Court be made payable to the Applicant
