Interlocutory orders sought

1. An order pursuant to rule 16.21 of the *Federal Court Rules 2011* (Cth) that paragraphs 1, and 34 to 41 of the Respondent's Statement of Claim, filed on 13 November 2023, be struck out on the basis that:
 - a. it is ambiguous as to whether the claims of the group members are in respect of, or arise out of, the same, similar, or related circumstances; further or in the alternative
 - b. it is ambiguous as to whether the claims of the group members give rise to a substantial common issue of law or fact; further or in the alternative
 - c. the description or identity of the group members to whom the proceedings relates is ambiguous.
2. An order pursuant to rule 16.21 of the *Federal Court Rules 2011* (Cth), that the following paragraphs of the Respondent's Statement of Claim, filed on 13 November 2023, be struck out:
 - a. Paragraphs 15,16, 18, 19, 24, 25, and 34 as the pleadings are evasive or ambiguous; and/or are likely to cause prejudice, embarrassment and/or delay; and/or fail to disclose a reasonable cause of action under s 9 of the *Racial Discrimination Act 1975*;
 - b. Paragraphs 26 to 33 and 35 to 41 as the pleadings fail to disclose a reasonable cause of action.
3. Costs.
4. Such other further or other order as the Court may consider appropriate.
