## Labor MP criticises 'ugly alliance between anti-trans bullies and neo-Nazis'

The clash between transgender rights protesters and neo-Nazis in Melbourne occurred in response to the Let Women Speak event held in the city today.

The event was hosted by the controversial British anti-trans rights figure **Kellie-Jay Keen** who is currently touring Australia.

The federal Labor MP Josh Burns called for "tougher laws" to be considered after black-clad marchers made Nazi salutes in front of Parliament House.

Both groups seek to bully and blame minority groups in their dark ideology. Scapegoating minorities is their business model, and it has no place in Australia.

The brazen marching with neo-Nazi salutes in front of the Victorian Parliament is unacceptable. This is a time for us to consider whether tougher laws are needed.

The protest in Melbourne came after Keen's events in Sydney and Adelaide this week were met with clashes between anti- and pro-trans rights activists. Keen is due to travel to Hobart on Tuesday and Canberra on Thursday before heading to New Zealand.

In January, the Greens MP **Stephen Bates** wrote to Australia's immigration minister asking him to revoke Keen's visa. Bates wrote on Twitter at the time:

**All** Today, I wrote to the Immigration Minister and called on him to revoke the visa of a prominent transphobe who poses a significant risk to members of the trans and gender diverse community of Australia.

There's no place for hate speech in this country. I won't be sharing their name because I don't want to amplify their hate speech. The Immigration Minister has the power to revoke his Government's decision to allow this individual to spread hateful views within our community.



Protestors have performed the Nazi salute and clashed with transgender rights activists as UK anti-trans activist **Kellie-Jay Keen** visited Melbourne.

About 30 people from far-right group National Socialist Movement marched along Spring Street near the Victorian Parliament on Saturday afternoon.

Disturbing footage showed masked protestors holding signs calling transgender people offensive names and performing Nazi salutes.

'Posie Parker is actively trying to build links between these far-right forces and broader anti-trans activists around the world.

Ms Keen, a self-described transphobe, had turned up to Melbourne after spending the past week visiting Sydney, Brisbane and Adelaide on her 'Let Women Speak' tour.


Controversial former Liberal candidate Katherine Deves was among the guest speakers as the protest spiralled into chaos.

Officers arrested at least two people, discharged pepper spray, and dragged away protestors by the arms.

One video showed a transgender rights activist rush onto the steps of Parliament House and snatch the microphone from a guest speaker, interrupting their speech.

Far-right group European Australia Movement founder Thomas Sewell was also spotted among the crowd.










## Kellie-Jay Keen event attracts supporters making Nazi salutes



There have been violent scenes in front of the Victorian Parliament as police clashed with peopl protesting against anti-transgender speaker Kellie-Jay Keen, while a neo-nazi group appeared alongside the 'Let Women Speak' event.

Said: Liberal MP Moira Deeming, who recently voiced her opposition to transgender people during her inaugural speech to the Victorian parliament, spoke at the event.

Also relevantly said:

At each event her supporters have been outnumbered by protesters and their chants have often been drowned out her followers' speeches. As she's travelled the country protesters have chanted "Posie Parker you can't hide, you've got nazis on your side."

A recent report in the UK linked Keen to the growing tide of anti-transgender sentiment and highlighted her links to farright political groups. At one of her recent events in the United Kingdom one of the speaker's began quoting Adolf Hitler's Mein Kampf.

The annual 'State of Hate' report from Hope Against Hate noted far right extremism is growing in the United Kingdom, and the report highlighted the role the campaigns of Kellie-Jay Keen were playing.

The report says Keen is "a leading voice in the anti-trans movement in the UK and has been praised by the far right. She has increasingly found support from and an overlap in views with the far right, which has also increasingly focused on trans people."


Today around 30 members of the far-right group Nationalist Socialist Movement marched down Spring Street in support of Keen, they shouted slurs at members of the LGBTIQA+ communities and their supporters, while unfurling a sign that read 'Destroy Paedo Freaks'.

Neo-Nazi salutes at protest could prompt changes to anti-vilification laws

The opposition said the display from the neo-Nazi group amounted to a deliberate attempt to incite hatred and violence.

"These shameful individuals and the hateful ideology they push have no place in our state and must never be tolerated," said Liberal MPs David Southwick and Brad Battin in a joint statement. "Victoria is better than this."

Southwick, whose seat of Caulfield includes Victoria's largest Jewish population, said on Sunday he had people calling him in tears about the vision they saw of the protest.

"We have the largest population of Holocaust survivors here in Caulfield and the last thing they want to be confronted with is Nazis saluting and goose-stepping outside parliament," he said.

"The Liberal-Nationals will stand side by side with the government to ensure that police have the powers they need to make sure they don't behave in this way."

Liberal MP Moira Deeming attended the anti-trans rights event and tweeted on Saturday of her disappointment with police for allowing the neo-Nazis to enter the protected area where Keen-Minshull was speaking.

About 30 people from neo-Nazi group the National Socialist Network, dressed in black and most with their faces covered, attended the protests on Spring Street supporting Keen-Minshull, repeatedly performing the salute and holding up a sign using offensive anti-trans language.

On Saturday night, a state government spokeswoman described the behaviour from the neo-Nazi group as a cowardly act of hatred and intimidation.

"Not only have Victorians made it clear they have zero tolerance for these disgraceful beliefs, we've made it clear in law with the ban of the Nazi hate symbol," she said.

Southwick said he did not share Deeming's views on transgender women, and said the party would speak with the upper house MP. "I had some initial discussions with Moira and I will have more," he said.

"I'm told many of those at the protests also felt unsafe from these neo-Nazis. There is one thing to protest, but it is another thing to incite hate.

Deeming was contacted for comment.

The Age revealed on Saturday that the Australian Army has launched an urgent investigation after discovering serving soldiers have links to neo-Nazi groups.

The inquiry was triggered by an investigation by The Age into white supremacist groups, which unearthed links between extremist groups and Australian Defence Force members, as well as state police forces.

The investigation also established the identities of emerging or previously unknown neo-Nazi leaders around the country, some with a keen interest in obtaining firearms and training in their use.

Premier Daniel Andrews condemned the Nazi salutes and anti-trans protesters in tweets on Sunday: "They were there to say the trans community don't deserve rights, safety or dignity. That's what Nazis do. Their evil ideology is to scapegoat minorities – and it's got no place here. And those who stand with them don't, either."

Opposition Leader John Pesutto also condemned the group's actions in a speech at the Victorian Multicultural Gala Dinner on Saturday night.

Andrews, who also spoke at the event, said the group's views were vile and represented the worst of Victoria. "I condemn that in the clearest terms."

Pesutto, who is also the shadow minister for multicultural affairs, described what happened on the steps of parliament as an abomination.

"I too will stand against it, I condemn it and I will work tirelessly with my colleagues to make sure it never gets a foothold here in our country or anywhere else."

Victoria Police said at least six groups attended the protest on Saturday, and officers were aware of the potential for multiple clashes between the opposing groups.

"Consequently, officers were required to form many lines between the different groups to protect the safety of all involved, stop breaches of the peace and prevent any physical violence," a spokeswoman said.

A group of trans, LGBTIQ+, multicultural, women's and other civil society organisations together on Sunday condemned the "hate speech and transphobic displays" that took place during the rally.

Trans Justice Project founder Jackie Turner said: "Trans people deserve to thrive. Yet right now, we are facing unprecedented attacks on our rights, lives and health care from anti-trans hate groups. I encourage everyone to stand in solidarity with the trans and gender diverse community in calling out these attacks."

Aleph Melbourne co-convenor Michael Barnett said: "White supremacy of this nature led to the persecution and murder of millions of Jews, LGBTIQ+ people and other minorities in World War II. There is no room for this ugly behaviour in Melbourne, or anywhere else. Transgender, gender diverse and all LGBTIQ+ people have a right to live in peace and safety, without fear of bigotry, transphobia or intolerance."

Victorian Premier Daniel Andrew has slammed protesters who performed the Nazi salute during an antitransgender rally that quickly turned violent, telling them Nazis are "not welcome" in the state

Large crowds of protesters from two competing rallies clashed in the streets of Melbourne over LGBTQI+ issues as an anti-transgender activist, Kellie-Jay Keen-Minshull, continues her speaking tour of Australia on Saturday.

The ugly display has already sparked calls for tougher laws to crack down on white supremacists from one Victorian MP, who said the display on parliament's steps was "unacceptable".

Ms Keen-Minshull, who goes by the moniker Posie Parker, is a British woman who founded group

She describes herself as a women's rights activist, but she is mostly known for her anti-transgender

It is not suggested she had any link with Saturday's violence.

But her controversial views are believed to have sparked the tense clash between anti-trans and protrans activists in front of Victoria's Parliament House
