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- 4. I have worked in legal technology, specialising in electronic discovery, since 2008.
- 5. I have led MinterEllison's Legal Technology team since November 2017.
- 6. I have significant experience advising, running, supervising and managing the legal technology of large scale litigation. This legal technology includes electronic document review tools and databases, the extraction of documents and electronic materials from third parties and the processing of those documents and materials for upload into a document review platform. I also have familiarity with the coding of documents obtained from third parties.
- 7. I have worked with MinterEllison's primary document review tool, Nuix Discover (Nuix) since 2008.
- 8. Nuix is a document review tool used to host, review, tag, redact and produce or discover client or third party documents. Nuix is most commonly used for electronic discovery or to review documents to be produced pursuant to, or received in response to, a notice to produce or subpoena.
- 9 In or about July 2021, MinterEllison's Legal Technology team set up a Nuix database to host the documents relevant to these proceedings on behalf of the Applicants (Case Database).
- 10. MinterEllison's Legal Technology team is responsible for administration of the Case Database, which includes processing and uploading documents from their original format into Nuix and into the Case Database.

### **Document IDs and Party Codes**

- 11. When a document is uploaded to the Case Database it is allocated a unique document identifier (Document ID). Document IDs follow a consistent format, as set out in the Federal Court's default document management guidelines for electronic discovery (Technology and the Court Practice Note, GPN-TECH). The first three letters of a Document ID are the **Party Code**, which typically identifies the source or party producing the document.
- 12. Party Codes are assigned at the point of processing and upload into Nuix and cannot be changed without considerable rework.
- 13. MinterEllison's Legal Technology team has allocated Party Codes to each document set that has been received in the proceedings and added to the Case Database. A document set is a particular tranche of material from one particular source, for example, documents produced by a particular entity in response to a subpoena. The Code has

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been allocated based on the source of the documents, which information has been obtained from, or confirmed with, solicitors working on these proceedings at MinterEllison.

- 14. Annexed and marked 'A' is a schedule detailing the Party Codes allocated by MinterEllison to material in the Case Database, together with the source of those documents and the party from whom those documents were received.
- These codes are displayed in Nuix in a data field called "Document Source".
  MinterEllison's Legal Technology team has reconciled the Document Source values against the list of Party Codes in Annexure A.
- 16. Various documents within the Case Database were provided to MinterEllison's Legal Technology Team by members of McGrathNicol's data management team including Victoria Larkin, Sara Deady, Chen Ji and Anisha Karel. These documents had unique document IDs associated with McGrathNicol's document management platform which followed the naming convention 'FOR.00000000' (where I refer to the numbers following the letters 'FOR' these numbers vary based on the individual document, with each document having a unique document ID).
- 17. Where documents sourced from McGrathNicol's document management platform have been subsequently uploaded to the Case Database they been allocated unique document IDs that are different to the McGrathNicol document IDs referred to at paragraph 16 above for the purpose of the Case Database. As outlined in Annexure A, the document IDs allocated to 'FOR.' documents received from McGrathNicol that are now hosted in the Case Database are:
  - (a) 'MCN';
  - (b) 'FGF.5000.0002'; and
  - (c) 'FOG.1000.0001';

### Deduplication

- 18. The documents under a Party Code in Nuix reflect the whole set of documents received from that source, except where documents have been de-duplicated.
- 19. Deduplication is an automated process applied to documents at processing and upload to Nuix. The digital contents of each document is converted to a unique fingerprint using an MD5 algorithm. Documents will have the same MD5 value only if they are exact digital copies.

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- 20. At the processing and upload stage, deduplication automatically identifies whether an exact digital copy of a document already exist in Nuix. If a copy already exists, the document is not loaded a second time. Instead, the existing document is updated to reflect any new information, such as a second Document Source.
- 21. As a result of deduplication, a document from one source may be identified by a Party Code of a different source, if an exact copy of the document had already been processed into Nuix. This is common for emails sent from one source to another, in which case the email sent within one source set is a digital copy of the email received in a different source set. Another common example is when a document is distributed to and saved by multiple custodians.
- 22. Deduplication is a commonly accepted process in electronic discovery to manage costs and to minimise document burden. The benefits from deduplication increase significantly as the number of sources of documents in the proceedings increase. MinterEllison's approach to deduplication is consistent with the Federal Court's default document management guidelines for electronic discovery.
