I think the Grace Tame stuff is a total distraction I'm afraid. It was a last minute thing that Lisa brought up when she arrived at the IV - not something we discussed beforehand otherwise I would have done my best to quash it.

Part of the gig being PM is to present the Australian of the Year award. It's unfortunate but also irrelevant that our talent was triggered by this moment - the PM presenting an award to a child abuse survivor (Tame was 15) is a long way from what our story is about.

The PM's fixer who's name appears in PART II is completely relevant. Having your chief fixer keeping tabs on a junior staffer is an actual link and in my view far more consequential.

When I was scripting this I considered dropping the chief fixer part when I was looking for time. Then it occurred to me that this in itself is really a key newsworthy part of the story - it's just there are so many awful newsworthy moments.
