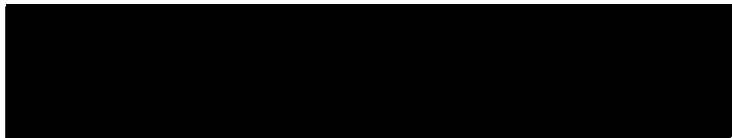
1. The Applicant have leave to discontinue the proceeding.
