- 4. I am authorised to make this affidavit in support of the Respondent's Interlocutory Application dated 9 May 2024 seeking non-publication orders in respect of Confidential Annexure MA-1 and Highly Confidential Exhibit MA-1 of the affidavit of Michael Anderson, affirmed on 1 May 2024, and the first sentence of paragraph 6(a) of my First Affidavit (collectively, the **Confidential Material**).
- 5. I am informed by Michael Anderson, Director of Engineering for Core Services for X and believe that:
  - (a) the Confidential Material deals with matters that are not publicly available and are confidential to X, including the internal processes X uses to analyse Hypertext Transfer Protocol Secure (HTTPS) requests that it receives at its data servers in the USA. The confidentiality arises from the commercially sensitive nature of the material, which includes confidential details of the way in which X's systems operate and the security measures implemented by X on its data servers and platform;
  - (b) X is a regular target of threat actors around the world. Accordingly, the details of X's internal systems are highly sensitive and are required to be kept confidential to avoid threat actors being able to use that information to circumvent X's internal processes;
  - (c) X's internal systems described in the Confidential Material also have a number of other important functions, including to assist X in enforcing its Terms of Service, as well as complying with laws governing sanctions, which would be threatened if the Confidential Material is not kept confidential;
  - (d) access by X's competitors to the confidential details of the way in which X's systems operate, which include highly commercially sensitive proprietary methods implemented by X, would result in significant commercial harm to X, because the information could be used to take unfair commercial advantage over X;
  - (e) Confidential Annexure MA-1 to Mr Anderson's affidavit contains parts of the body of the affidavit which are confidential; and
  - (f) Highly Confidential Exhibit MA-1 to Mr Anderson's affidavit contains highly commercially sensitive data used by X to determine a user's location.
