- 2. I make this affidavit in support of Mr McGowan's application for orders that Mr McGowan and Mr John Quigley be permitted to give evidence at the hearing of these proceedings by audio-visual link.
- 3. The matters to which I depose below are true to my own knowledge, save where stated otherwise, in which case they are true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I set out the source of that knowledge and belief.

### Audio-visual facilities in the Perth office of Clayton Utz

- 4. The Infrastructure Services department of the Perth Clayton Utz office (ISD) is responsible for, among other things, the facilitation of all technology services at the firm. These services include making arrangements for the preparation and conduct of all activities involving remote access technology.
- 5. I am informed by Mr Graham Ellis, Team Leader of ISD in the Perth office of Clayton Utz, and verily believe that the Perth office of Clayton Utz is equipped with appropriate resources that enable all persons present in hearings facilitated using remote access technology to be seen and heard clearly. Those resources, in relation to the meeting room in which the hearing of these proceedings would be conducted remotely, include:
  - (a) dual 75-inch wall-mounted screens that enable high definition quality of picture;
  - (b) Polycom model of videoconferencing system;
  - (c) a table large enough to seat approximately 10 people, with enough space for the use of any physical documentation;
  - (d) microphones and speakers installed externally on the tabletop as well as in the ceiling of the meeting room, to increase the clarity and quality of sound passing through the microphones and received through the speakers;
  - (e) touch control panels on the tabletop to enable any changes to video (such as angle or zoom) or sound (such as muting or unmuting a microphone or increasing volume) to be made easily and quickly; and

- (f) internet connection to two separate internet providers to account for any unexpected failures of one internet provider, with a bandwidth of 250Mbs.
- 6. I am also informed by Mr Ellis and verily believe that:
  - (a) the facilities set out in paragraph 5 above are compatible, and have been successfully used in conjunction, with the Federal Court's preferred remote access technology system, Microsoft Teams (**Teams**); and
  - (b) given that Teams is the Court's preferred remote hearing system and is widely used across the world, it is expected that the hearing of these proceedings will be as secure as any other communication facilitated by Teams.
- 7. If the hearing of these proceedings were to be conducted using Teams and any technical issues arise, at least one member of ISD would be available to immediately attend to that issue in combination with Court staff.
